

Reasons for the Conduct of the Study in the University

- Lack of comprehensive tracer study data
- Need for more tracer study data for varied purposes; namely accreditation, curricular review, study provision assessment, policy formulation.
- Need for fine tuning of existing tracer study systems and procedures.



- The Benguet State University is a regional university of the Cordillera Administrative Region located at the North Central Luzon of the Philippines.
- It has a Graduate School, 8 faculties and 2 academic institutes.

Objectives of the BSU Tracer Study

- General: To trace the destination of the BSU graduates since they left the university.
- Specifically, this tracer aimed to determine the following:
- 1. Socio-economic characteristics, education and work before and after graduation at BSU;
- 2. Study conditions and provisions, study experiences as perceived by the graduates;


Specific Objectives continued...

- 3. Status of work transition and employment of the graduates; and
- 4. Extent of acquisition of competencies by graduates, contribution of the acquisition of the competencies and utilization of the competencies in their work.

Data Collection Method


- Courier-based questionnaires

- Conducting interviews




THE 2009 BSU GRADUATES AS COHORT OF THE TRACER STUDY




Percentage Of Respondents by Discipline











Extent of Emphasis on the Modes of Teaching



Rate of Study Conditions




Rate of Study Experiences




Rate of Study Provision






Means of Job Search






Aspects Considered for Accepting the First Job



Extent of Usefulness of the Courses on the following Endeavours







Extent of Acquisition, Contribution of the University, and Utilization of Competencies



• Completed study program within the required period of time.

 Short duration for job search, 2.3 and 2.8 months before and after graduation, respectively to an average of 4 companies/institutions.

• Acknowledged and invited for an interview by at least 2 of the companies/institutions.

• Advertisements in newspapers, magazines and flyers are the means of job search.

 Study programme, specialization, grades and English proficiency are the ranking criteria used by the employers in employing the graduates.

• Graduates are either employed in the public or private companies/ institutions.

- Sectors of employment are Professional, Education, Household Activities, Retail Trade, Personal Services.
- Higher rating on the extent of acquisition and utilization as compared to the extent of contribution by the University in the acquisition of the competencies.
- Mismatch between study and employment.


