

Male – Female Ratio











Tracer Study


- Conducted in 2011 by the university

 - 58 response (59.79%)






Result: Waiting Time









Result: Income





Result: Job – IT Relatedness









Result: Willingness to Work in Rural Areas

• Male: 65% Female: 44%






Result: Loyalty
