- Until 2010: no regular tracer studies
- ■2010: Establishment of tracer studies project: "Absolventii si Piata Muncii" ("University Graduates and Labor Market") by UEFISCDI (Executive Agency for Higher Education, Research, Development and Innovation Funding)




Absolventii si Piata Muncii

- Project partially financed by the European Social Fund
- Coordination by UEFISCDI

- Participation of 56 Universities

Workshops and Conferences

Tracer study for the cohorts 2005 and 2009 (field phase November 2010 – March 2011)

- June 2010: Questionnaire development
- November 2010: Conducting the field phase
- May 2011: Data cleaning and analysis
- November 2011: Dissemination of the results

Participation and contributions of all universities



Participation of the Universities

- A project coordinator is involved in
 - Questionnaire development
 - Conducting the field phase (address validating and updating, inviting the graduates)
 - Data analysis and interpretation (each university receives its own dataset, with the possibility of comparing with the national results)
 - Dissemination of the results within the university



Methodological Aspects

- 1. Multipurpose surveys (broad scope; about 500 variables)
- 2. Regularity: Every year one cohort
- 3. Two cohorts: 1.5 year after graduation + 4.5 years after graduation
- 4. Census: all bachelor graduates, no sampling
- 5. Standardized online questionnaire
- 6. Every university has an own questionnaire
- 7. Network approach, cooperation
- 8. Training for network members



Response Rate

Survey of the cohort 2009 (Field phase November 2010 – March 2011)


- Total number of graduates: 152,000
- Total number of contacted graduates: 107,000
- Total number of responses: 38,800

Gross response rate: 26 % Net response rate: 36 %



Response Development

- Field phase with three reminder contacts
- Considerably parallel conduction by the universities



Continuation of the Tracer Study

- Conduction of the tracer study for the cohorts 2006 and 2010 in April 2012
- Participation of 42 universities
